Council Poster Guide

Add your council logo and event time to a Great Global Mend A4, A3, or A1 poster for print using an LLM such as Claude Cowork.

What You Need

- Your white .PNG council logo file, transparent background, 300dpi. Include at least 10% transparent padding on all sides of the logo within the PNG canvas. This prevents the logo sitting too close to other elements on the poster.
- Your event start and end times (e.g. 10am - 12pm)

Step-by-Step Instructions

Step 1 - Download a poster

- Download a poster (A4, A3, or A1 size)
- The poster includes a logo indicator space and an example event time - these will be replaced with your logo and time
- Save the poster somewhere easy to find on your computer

Step 2 - Open your LLM and upload the poster and your logo

- Open your preferred LLM and upload the Poster PDF you just downloaded
- Upload your council logo PNG file (white, transparent background, 300dpi)

Step 3 - Copy and paste the prompt for your poster size

Find your poster size below. Copy the prompt exactly as written, replace both placeholders with your details, and paste it into your LLM.

A4 Poster - Copy this prompt:
